Prof. Toon Van Gorp is a prominent gynaecologist-oncologist at UZ Leuven, Belgium, where he specializes in various types of gynaecological cancers, including ovarian, cervical, uterine, and vulvar cancers. He earned his medical degree from KU Leuven in 1999 and currently leads the Gynaecological Oncology department at the Leuven Cancer Institute. His research focuses on translational studies and clinical trials, particularly in early drug development for gynaecological cancers. Prof. Van Gorp is also actively involved in professional organizations, serving as the chair of the Belgium and Luxembourg Gynaecological Oncology Group (BGOG) and as a member of the strategic group of the European Network of Gynaecological Oncological Trial Groups (ENGOT). He is recognized for his contributions to the field, including research on homologous recombination deficiency testing and predictive genetic markers for targeted therapy in gynaecological cancers.
